I still believe I'm within agree policy, I'm now seeking \$508 per night from 6/10/18 until the rebuild is completed or handover. This has escalated from my original request base on the story line which I have been significantly far and exceeded my objections throughout this process.

I have taken today off work and waiting on IDR to response to me today as it's the 15th working, I have email IDR today and not recessive a response by 2PM.

I have just lodged a complaint with financial ombudsman Case Number: [REDACTED]

I informed Aami the a potential delay handing over the rebuild leading up to my first born and Xmas, now the temp occupancy has expired leaving us homeless

It took my primary builder three and a half months will start to finish typically the whole house

You have quote a similar estimate,

There are about 3 or 5 public holidays, Therefore you have plenty of time to find the appropriate trades special Union dispensation Worksafe requirements or any other permits or needs to complete this task before 2018 have you acquired this?.

Addition costing to labour for dispensations etc.

Scopes need been updated its foundations of scoops is open to variations approximate figures,

Aami has 2 builders' quotes works and only released cash settlement is significans undervalue approximate two and half's mouths after event, this is a restriction of trade to get serval quotations in or soured trades fairly.

At this stage repairs can start on our home has been unliveable 6/10/18! Exactly what you pushed into this direction without housing temp and long term.
