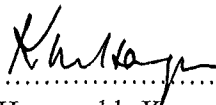
**NON-PUBLICATION DIRECTION
PURSUANT TO SECTION 6D(3)**

Pursuant to s 6D(3) of the *Royal Commissions Act 1902* (Cth), I direct that so much of the contents of:

- (a) documents identified as Category 1 of the Annexure to the submissions provided to the Commission by National Australia Bank Limited (**NAB**) on 9 March 2018 (**Revised Annexure**) as discloses any contact or identifying information of customers of NAB;
- (b) documents identified as Category 2 of the Revised Annexure as disclose any identifying information of employees of NAB against whom allegations of misconduct have been made, or, in respect of whom, in the context of the particular document, or who, it is suggested, have been involved in misconduct;
- (c) documents identified as Category 3 of the Revised Annexure as discloses any direct contact information of employees of NAB;
- (d) documents identified as Category 4 in the Revised Annexure as discloses any contact information of third parties;
- (e) documents identified as Category 5 in the Revised Annexure as discloses any personal or identifying information of third parties (such as introducers or persons associated with introducers in connection with matters being investigated by NAB); and
- (f) documents in the Revised Annexure as disclose the bank account numbers of customers of NAB,

not be published except to the Commission, its staff and counsel and solicitors assisting the Commission, and to NAB and its counsel and solicitors.
