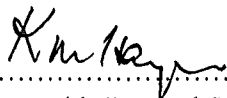
**NON-PUBLICATION DIRECTION
PURSUANT TO SECTION 6D(3)**

Pursuant to s 6D(3) of the *Royal Commissions Act* 1902 (Cth), I direct that so much of the contents of the submissions provided to the Commission by Westpac Banking Corporation (**Westpac**) under Notices to Produce NP-001, NP-035, NP-070 and NP-099 as discloses:

- (a) any contact or identifying information of customers of Westpac;
- (b) any identifying information of employees of Westpac against whom allegations of misconduct have been made, or, in respect of whom, in the context of the particular document, it is suggested have been involved in misconduct;
- (c) any direct contact information of employees of Westpac;
- (d) any contact or identifying information of third parties; and
- (e) any information that would reveal the identity of a whistleblower of Westpac; and
- (f) any information that would reveal Westpac's processes and systems for preventing, detecting and responding to fraudulent behaviour in relation to applications received by Westpac for asset finance,

not be published except to the Commission, its staff and counsel and solicitors assisting the Commission, and to Westpac and its counsel and solicitors.
