
**NON-PUBLICATION DIRECTION
PURSUANT TO SECTION 6D(3)**

Pursuant to s 6D(3) of the *Royal Commissions Act 1902* (Cth), I direct that:

- (a) so much of the contents of the signed statement dated 1 March 2018 of evidence of Heang Forbes (**Forbes Statement**), and the documents exhibited to the Forbes Statement, as discloses:
 - (i) any direct contact information, and signatures, of employees of Australia and New Zealand Banking Group Limited (**ANZ**) and third parties; and
 - (ii) any contact or identifying information, including names, account numbers and account information, of customers of ANZ;
- (b) the whole of the contents of subparagraphs 38(a) and (b) of the Forbes Statement;
- (c) so much of the contents of paragraphs 33 and 68 of the Forbes Statement as discloses the numbers shaded by ANZ in those paragraphs in the version of the Forbes Statement provided to the Commission on 2 March 2018;
- (d) so much of the contents of Exhibit HF1 to the Forbes Statement as discloses the information shaded by ANZ in the version of Exhibit HF1 provided to the Commission on 2 March 2018 (**2 March version**), other than the two dot points on page ANZ.800.255.7834 of the 2 March version; and
- (e) the whole of the contents of Exhibit HF3 to the Forbes Statement,

not be published except to the Commission, its staff and counsel and solicitors assisting the Commission, and to ANZ and its counsel and solicitors.
