
**NON-PUBLICATION DIRECTION
PURSUANT TO SECTION 6D(3)**

Pursuant to s 6D(3) of the *Royal Commissions Act 1902* (Cth), I direct that so much of the contents of the signed statement dated 15 March 2018 of the evidence of Nalini Devi Thiruvangadam, and the documents exhibited to that statement, as discloses:

- (a) the direct contact and identifying information of Ms Thiruvangadam (other than Ms Thiurvangadam's name) including bank account numbers and insurance policy numbers;
- (b) the location and name of the car dealership referred to in paragraph 11 of Ms Thiruvangadam's signed statement, and any direct contact and identifying information of employees of that car dealership;
- (c) the direct contact information of employees of Westpac Banking Corporation (**Westpac**);
- (d) the direct contact information of employees of Ms Thiruvangadam's former employer, Mecwacare or other third parties,

not be published except to the Commission, its staff and counsel and solicitors assisting the Commission, and to Ms Thiruvangadam and her counsel and solicitors, and to Westpac and its counsel and solicitors.
