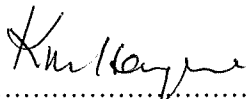

PURSUANT TO SECTION 6D(3)**

SCHEDULE A

CBA

- (a) So much of the contents of document CBA.0508.0003.0011 as discloses any direct contact information of employees of CBA or third parties.

Westpac

- (b) So much of the contents of the documents exhibited to the statement, dated 19 March 2018, of evidence of William David Malcolm as discloses any personal or identifying information of customers of Westpac.

ASIC

- (c) So much of the documents ASIC.0011.0004.0219, ASIC.0011.0004.0227, ASIC.0010.0004.0259 and ASIC.0012.0003.1696 as discloses any direct contact information of employees of ASIC or employees of Australia and New Zealand Banking Group Limited.
- (d) So much of the document ASIC.0010.0004.0259 as discloses the name of the car dealership identified on the first page of that document.

DEFINITIONS

For the purposes of this Direction:

1. 'ASIC' means Australian Securities and Investments Commission.
2. 'CBA' means Commonwealth Bank of Australia.
3. 'Westpac' means Westpac Banking Corporation.
