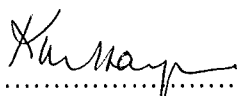
**NON-PUBLICATION DIRECTION

not be published except to the Commission, its staff and counsel and solicitors assisting the Commission, and to CBA and its counsel and solicitors.
