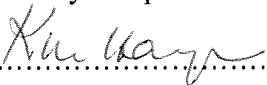

- (b) the direct contact information of employees or advisers of Westpac, any Westpac associated entity or employees of the Australian Securities and Investments Commission (**ASIC**); and
- (c) identifying information of employees or advisers of Westpac or a Westpac associated entity against whom allegations of misconduct have been made, or, in respect of whom, in the context of the particular document, it is suggested have been involved in misconduct, other than the name of the following individuals and entities:
 - (i) Ramakrishnan Mahadevan;
 - (ii) Andrew Smith; and
 - (iii) Karl Sleiman,

not be published except to the Commission, its staff and counsel and solicitors assisting the Commission, and to Westpac and its counsel and solicitors.
