PURSUANT TO SECTION 6D(3)**

Pursuant to s 6D(3) of the *Royal Commissions Act 1902* (Cth), I direct that so much of the contents of the statement of evidence of Kylie Elizabeth Rixon provided to the Commission in respect of Rubric 2-16, and the documents to be exhibited to that statement, as discloses:

- (a) the ANZ process that are currently being developed by ANZ for the purpose of detecting instances of fraud by ANZ financial advisers, except:
 - (i) the items in exhibit KR-13 at rows 27 to 37 of Colum C in the sheet titled “Original KRI List”
 - (ii) the items in exhibit KR-13 at rows 2 to 6 of Colum C in the sheet titled “Final KRIs – June 17”;
- (b) the commercial information belonging to ANZ (in the form of information about the pricing structures between ANZ’s aligned dealer groups and their authorised representatives) contained in annexures KR-7, KR-9 and KR-10;
- (c) the direct contact details and signatures of employees of Australia and New Zealand Banking Group Limited (ANZ) and the contact details for internal teams within ANZ;
- (d) the direct contact details of employees of third parties;
- (e) the details of specific usernames and passwords used by ANZ for certain websites and/or platforms;

not be published except to the Commission, its staff and counsel and solicitors assisting the Commission, and to ANZ and its counsel and solicitors.
