
**NON-PUBLICATION DIRECTION
PURSUANT TO SECTION 6D(3)**

Pursuant to s 6D(3) of the *Royal Commissions Act 1902* (Cth), I direct that so much of the contents of the statement of evidence of Mr Alastair Welsh in response to Rubric 3-12, as discloses:

- (a) contact and identifying information of customers of Westpac Banking Corporation and its associated entities (within the meaning of that term as defined in s 50AAA of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth)) (collectively, **Westpac**), except for Carolyn Flanagan's name and signature;
- (b) contact and identifying information of customers of any third parties;
- (c) contact and identifying information of the valuer and the valuer's firm referred to in WBC.407.0001.0228;
- (d) contact and identifying information of the solicitor and the solicitor's law firm referred to at paragraph 81 of Mr Welsh's statement;
- (e) in relation to WBC.400.043.6558, the information identified by Westpac as commercially sensitive in its application dated 9 May 2018;
- (f) in relation to pages ending .9630 and .9631 of WBC.410.001.9483, the information identified by Westpac as commercially sensitive in its application dated 17 May 2018;
- (g) direct contact information of employees of Westpac and employees of any third parties, including the Financial Ombudsman Service (**FOS**); and
- (h) identifying information of any individuals against whom allegations of misconduct have been made, or, in respect of whom, in the context of the particular document, it is suggested have been involved in misconduct,

not be published except to the Commission, its staff and counsel and solicitors assisting the Commission, and to Westpac and its counsel and solicitors.
