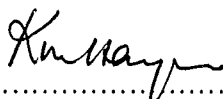
**NON-PUBLICATION DIRECTION  
PURSUANT TO SECTION 6D(3)**

Pursuant to s 6D(3) of the *Royal Commissions Act 1902* (Cth), I direct that so much of the contents of the statement of evidence of Mr David Carter in response to Rubric 3-21, and the documents exhibited to that statement, as discloses:

- (a) contact and identifying information of customers of Suncorp Group Limited and its associated entities (within the meaning of that term as defined in s 50AAA of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth)) (collectively, **Suncorp**), except for Ms Jennifer Low's name, Mr Rein Low's name and Mr Peter Low's name, and any business names or addresses related to those individuals;
- (b) direct contact information of employees of Suncorp and employees of any third parties;
- (c) the information identified as commercially sensitive in Suncorp's application for non-publication directions dated 17 May 2018;
- (d) identifying information of the Suncorp employee referred to at paragraph 67(kk) of Mr Carter's statement;
- (e) the name of the Suncorp employee referred to at paragraphs 14, 16, 17, 21, 23 and 46 of the statement of evidence of Mr Rein Low dated 23 May 2018; and
- (f) identifying information of any individuals against whom allegations of misconduct have been made, or, in respect of whom, in the context of the particular document, it is suggested have been involved in misconduct,

not be published except to the Commission, its staff and counsel and solicitors assisting the Commission, and to Suncorp and its counsel and solicitors.
