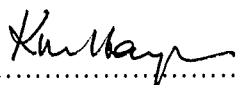
**NON-PUBLICATION DIRECTION
PURSUANT TO SECTION 6D(3)**

Pursuant to s 6D(3) of the *Royal Commissions Act 1902* (Cth), I direct that so much of the contents of the statement of evidence of Mr Howard Silby in response to Rubric 3-19, and the documents exhibited to that statement, as discloses:

- (a) contact and identifying information of customers of National Australia Bank Limited and its associated entities (within the meaning of that term as defined in s 50AAA of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth)) (collectively, **NAB**), except for Mr Ross Dillon's name, and the names of the businesses National Music Pty Ltd or Mr and Mrs Dillon t/a Goanna Downs;
- (b) direct contact information of employees of NAB and employees of any third parties;
- (c) names of any current or former employees of NAB which is revealed in the context of any performance rating, appraisal and/or remuneration review; and
- (d) identifying information of any individuals against whom allegations of misconduct have been made, or, in respect of whom, in the context of the particular document, it is suggested have been involved in misconduct,

not be published except to the Commission, its staff and counsel and solicitors assisting the Commission, and to NAB and its counsel and solicitors.
