
**NON-PUBLICATION DIRECTION  
PURSUANT TO SECTION 6D(3)**

Pursuant to s 6D(3) of the *Royal Commissions Act 1902* (Cth), I direct that so much of the contents of the statement of evidence of Sinead Taylor provided to the Commission in respect of Rubric 4-24, and the documents exhibited to that statement, as discloses:
