**NON-PUBLICATION DIRECTION
PURSUANT TO SECTION 6D(3)**

Pursuant to s 6D(3) of the *Royal Commissions Act 1902* (Cth), I direct that so much of the contents of the statements of evidence of Bradley James provided to the Commission in respect of Rubric 4-16, and the documents exhibited to that statement, as discloses:


- (a) contact and identifying information of customers of Rabobank Australia Limited and its associated entities (within the meaning of that term as defined in s 50AAA of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth)) (collectively (**Rabobank**)), except for:
 - (i) Mrs Wendy Brauer's name,
 - (ii) Mr Adrian Brauer's name,
 - (iii) Mr Tom Campbell's name,
 - (iv) Mr Paul Wright's name,
 - (v) Ms Marina Wright's name,
 - (vi) Mr Timothy Wright's name,
 - (vii) Ms Caroline Herring's name,
 - (viii) the names of the properties "Kia-Ora", "Jamberoo" and "Nankeen"; and
 - (ix) the towns and States of the properties referred to in paragraph (viii);
- (b) the direct contact information of employees of Rabobank or employees of any third parties;
- (c) identifying information of any individuals against whom allegations of misconduct have been made, or, in respect of whom, in the context of the particular document, it is suggested have been involved in misconduct,

not be published except to the Commission, its staff and counsel and solicitors assisting the Commission, and to Rabobank and its counsel and solicitors.
