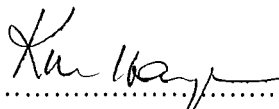
**NON-PUBLICATION DIRECTION
PURSUANT TO SECTION 6D(3)**

Pursuant to s 6D(3) of the *Royal Commissions Act 1902* (Cth), I direct that so much of the contents of the statement of evidence of Benjamin Steinberg provided to the Commission in respect of Rubric 4-01, and the documents exhibited to that statement, as discloses:

- (a) contact and identifying information of customers of Australia and New Zealand Banking Group Limited and its associated entities (within the meaning of that term as defined in s 50AAA of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth)) (collectively (ANZ)), except for:

 - (ii) Michael Hirst's name; and

- (b) the direct contact information and signatures of employees of ANZ or employees of any third parties; and
- (c) in relation to BWS-21, the information the subject of ANZ's application for non-publication directions dated 28 May 2018,

not be published except to the Commission, its staff and counsel and solicitors assisting the Commission, and to ANZ and its counsel and solicitors.
