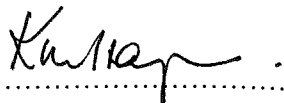
**NON-PUBLICATION DIRECTION

 - ii) the word "NIL" appearing three times in the right hand column of the table in SUN.0760.0316.0013 at 0053,

not be published except to the Commission, its staff and counsel and solicitors assisting the Commission, and to AAI and its counsel and solicitors.
