
**NON-PUBLICATION DIRECTION
PURSUANT TO SECTION 6D(3)**

Pursuant to s 6D(3) of the *Royal Commissions Act 1902* (Cth), I direct that so much of the contents of the statement of evidence of David Krawitz provided to the Commission in respect of Rubric 4-03A, and the documents exhibited to that statement, as discloses:

- (a) contact and identifying information of customers of Allianz Australia Insurance Limited and its associated entities (within the meaning of that term as defined in s 50AAA of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth)) (collectively **Allianz**);
- (b) direct contact information of employees of Allianz or employees of any third parties;
- (c) in relation to ALZ.0001.0051.0089, contact and identifying information of the supplier, and the information on page .0105 identified by Allianz as commercially sensitive in its application for non-publication directions dated 22 June 2018;
- (d) in relation to ALZ.0001.0051.0001, contact and identifying information of the builder, and the figure under the heading 'Average Cost',

not be published except to the Commission, its staff and counsel and solicitors assisting the Commission, and to Allianz and its counsel and solicitors.
