PURSUANT TO SECTION 6D(3)**


Pursuant to s 6D(3) of the *Royal Commissions Act 1902* (Cth), I direct that so much of the contents of the statements of evidence of Russell Howden provided to the Commission in respect of Rubrics 4-23, 4-31 and 4-42, and the documents exhibited to those statements, as discloses:

- (a) contact and identifying information of customers of Select AFSL Pty Limited and its associated entities (within the meaning of that term as defined in s 50AAA of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth)) (collectively **Select**), except Ms Kathy Marika's name and the fact that that she lived in Condobolin in the State of NSW;
- (b) the contact and identifying information of Ms Marika's relatives and friends (including names, ages and dates of birth of her children and grandchildren);
- (c) the bank account details of Ms Marika;
- (d) the amount of Centrelink Newstart benefits, and Family Tax benefits, Ms Marika received from time to time;
- (e) contact and identifying information of the addressees in the letters with the document references SAF.0005.0001.0091, SAF.0005.0001.0001 and SAF.0005.0001.0092;
- (f) contact and identifying information of customers of any third parties; and
- (g) the direct contact information of employees of Select, the employees of the Australian Securities and Investments Commission or employees of any third parties,

not be published except to the Commission, its staff and counsel and solicitors assisting the Commission, and to Select and its counsel and solicitors.

This direction revokes and replaces DIR-178 made on 8 June 2018 and DIR-183 made on 12 June 2018.
