**NON-PUBLICATION DIRECTION  
PURSUANT TO SECTION 6D(3)**

Pursuant to s 6D(3) of the *Royal Commissions Act 1902* (Cth), I direct that so much of the contents of the statement of evidence of Mr Stephen Bracks AC provided to the Commission in respect of Rubric 5-13, and the documents exhibited to that statement, as discloses:

- (a) names and other identifying information of current and former employees or officers of United Super Pty Ltd and its associated entities (within the meaning of that term as defined in s 50AAA of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth)) (collectively, **United Super**), where that information is revealed in the context of any performance review;
- (b) direct contact details and signatures of current and former employees or officers of United Super;
- (c) direct contact details and signatures of any third parties;
- (d) in relation to CBUS.0002.0001.0359, the information the subject of United Super's application for non-publication directions dated 19 July 2018 (**United Super Application**); and
- (e) in relation to CBUS.0002.0001.0001, the information the subject of the United Super Application, except for the information on page .0045,

not be published except to the Commission, its staff and counsel and solicitors assisting the Commission, and to United Super and its counsel and solicitors.
