**NON-PUBLICATION DIRECTION
PURSUANT TO SECTION 6D(3)**

Pursuant to s 6D(3) of the *Royal Commissions Act 1902* (Cth), I direct that so much of the contents of the statement of evidence of Mr Edward Cooley provided to the Commission in respect of Rubric 5-23, and the documents exhibited to that statement, as discloses:


- (a) names and other identifying information of current and former employees or officers of Suncorp Group Limited and its associated entities (within the meaning of that term as defined in s 50AAA of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth)) (collectively, **Suncorp**), where that information is revealed in the context of any performance review;
- (b) direct contact details and signatures of current and former employees or officers of Suncorp;
- (c) direct contact details and signatures of any third parties;
- (d) the information in SUN.1506.0014.0222 and SUN.1506.0014.0038;
- (e) in relation to SUN.1506.0002.7133, the final sentence of the fifth row in the column headed "Core positives";
- (f) in relation to SUN.1506.0014.0024, the information identified in Suncorp's application for non-publication directions dated 26 July 2018, other than:
 - (i) the information on page .0026; and
 - (ii) the row entitled 'Under/outperformance' on pages .0029-.0030;
- (g) in relation to SUN.1201.0701.0068, the information identified in Suncorp's application for non-publication directions dated 13 July 2018; and
- (h) in relation to SUN.1506.0002.7096, the information identified in Suncorp's application for non-publication directions dated 26 July 2018, other than:
 - (i) on page .7098, the figures \$2.7m, \$2.5m and \$2.1m; and



(ii) on page .7099, the first bullet point (expect for the dollar figure), and the first indented bullet point,

not be published except to the Commission, its staff and counsel and solicitors assisting the Commission, and to Suncorp and its counsel and solicitors.
