**NON-PUBLICATION DIRECTION
PURSUANT TO SECTION 6D(3)**

Pursuant to s 6D(3) of the *Royal Commissions Act 1902* (Cth), I direct that so much of the contents of the statement of evidence of Mr Andrew Fraser provided to the Commission in respect of Rubric 5-51, and the documents exhibited to that statement, as discloses:

- (a) names and other identifying information of current and former employees or officers of Sunsuper Pty Ltd and its associated entities (within the meaning of that term as defined in s 50AAA of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth)) (collectively, **Sunsuper**), where that information is revealed in the context of any performance review;
- (b) direct contact details and signatures of current and former employees or officers of Sunsuper;
- (c) direct contact details and signatures of any third parties;
- (d) the names of the employers referred to in paragraph 37 of the statement of Mr Fraser;
- (e) the percentage and dollar figures referred to in paragraphs 315 and 316 of the statement of Mr Fraser;
- (f) in relation to SSU.2001.0001.1544 and SSU.2001.0001.0010, the information identified as commercially sensitive in Sunsuper's application for non-publication directions (**Sunsuper Application**);
- (g) in relation to SSU.2001.0001.0894, the dollar figures referred to in that document; and
- (h) in relation to SSU.2001.0001.1474, the dollar figures on page .1484,



not be published except to the Commission, its staff and counsel and solicitors assisting the Commission, and to Sunsuper and its counsel and solicitors.
