PURSUANT TO SECTION 6D(3)**

Pursuant to s 6D(3) of the *Royal Commissions Act 1902* (Cth), I direct that so much of the contents of the statements of evidence of Mr Peter Mullin provided to the Commission in respect of Rubric 5-28 and Rubric 5-29, and the documents exhibited to those statements, as discloses:



- (c) personal financial information belonging to the directors of Oasis Fund Management Limited and OnePath Custodians Pty Limited (in the form of their shareholdings in financial planning and wealth management entities);
- (d) details of usernames and passwords used by ANZ for certain websites or platforms;
- (e) in relation to ANZ.800.808.0002:
 - (i) the information on page .0009 the subject of ANZ's application for non-publication directions dated 16 July 2018;
 - (ii) the figures associated with each of the bar graphs on page .0012; and
 - (iii) the market growth figure referred to on page .0012;
- (f) in relation to ANZ.800.808.0014:
 - (i) the figures associated with each of the bar graphs on pages .0028 and .0029; and
 - (ii) the market growth figure referred to on pages .0028 and .0029; and



- (g) in relation to ANZ.800.813.0008, the figures in each of the charts and tables the subject of ANZ's application for non-publication directions dated 16 July 2018 (but not any descriptions of those figures),

not be published except to the Commission, its staff and counsel and solicitors assisting the Commission, and to ANZ and its counsel and solicitors.
