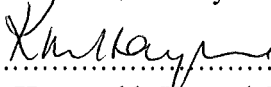
**NON-PUBLICATION DIRECTION
PURSUANT TO SECTION 6D(3)**

Pursuant to s 6D(3) of the *Royal Commissions Act 1902* (Cth), I direct that so much of the contents of the statement of Paul John Sainsbury responsive to Rubric 6-30 and Rubric 6-31, and the documents exhibited to that statement, as discloses:

- (a) contact and identifying information of customers AMP Life Limited and its associated entities (within the meaning of that term as defined in s 50AAA of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth)) (AMP);
- (b) direct contact details of employees of AMP;
- (c) direct contact details of third parties; and
- (d) in relation to AMP.6000.0128.5995:
 - (i) the information identified in AMP's application for non-publication directions dated 3 September 2018;
 - (ii) the names of any employers who currently have corporate superannuation plans with AMP, including any mandate amounts relevant to those employers;
 - (iii) the names of any corporate authorised representatives of AMP,

not be published except to the Commission, its staff and counsel and solicitors assisting the Commission, and to AMP and its counsel and solicitors.
