PURSUANT TO SECTION 6D(3)**

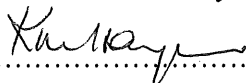

- (e) in relation to TAL.500.040.0039, TAL.500.040.0058, TAL.500.040.0060 and TAL.500.039.0968, the information identified in TAL's application for non-publication directions dated 3 September 2018;
- (f) in relation to TAL.500.039.0432, TAL.500.039.0480 and TAL.500.039.0554, the information identified in TAL's application for non-publication directions dated 6 September 2018; and
- (g) in relation to TAL.500.041.0001, the information identified in TAL's application for non-publication directions dated 3 September 2018, other than:
- (h) any conditions disclosed to TAL by Ms Wisbey when she applied for her income protection policy; and
- (i) any conditions which TAL alleges or has previously alleged that Ms Wisbey failed to disclose to TAL.
