**SUPPLEMENTARY SUBMISSIONS OF NATIONAL AUSTRALIA BANK – IMPROPER CONDUCT
CASE STUDY¹**

1. This submission is supplementary to NAB's submission filed on 4 May 2018 and is made in response to a letter received from the Commission on 8 May 2018.
2. NAB was unaware prior to receipt of that letter that the Commission had been in contact with Mr Meyn. In particular, NAB had not received any indication (whether from the Commission or otherwise) that Mr Meyn had been provided with Mr Hagger's statement, invited to provide a signed statement and been told that it was open to him to apply for leave to appear.
3. In view of these matters, NAB withdraws the statement that "Mr Meyn has not been given an opportunity to be heard" in paragraph 40 of its submissions dated 4 May 2018.
