

COMMISSION OF INQUIRY INTO
MISCONDUCT IN THE BANKING, SUPERANNUATION AND
FINANCIAL SERVICES INDUSTRY

ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO APPEAR

1. Pursuant to s 6FA of the *Royal Commissions Act 1902* (Cth), each applicant listed in Schedule A has leave:
 - (a) to appear at the hearings commencing on 6 August 2018;
 - (b) to examine any witness that the applicant has nominated to give evidence during the hearings;
 - (c) to cross examine any other witness to the extent that the witness has given evidence during the hearings about the conduct of the applicant;
 - (d) to make written submissions at the conclusion of the hearings:
 - (i) about what findings of fact, if any, may be made about conduct of the applicant examined in the course of the hearings; and
 - (ii) about an issue which the applicant can demonstrate to be an issue in which the applicant has a direct and substantial interest.
2. Examination and cross-examination of witnesses is to be conducted and submissions are to be made in accordance with the Practice Guidelines of the Royal Commission.
3. The leave now granted may be extended or narrowed from time to time with respect to any or all of the applicants listed in Schedule A.
