COMMISSION OF INQUIRY INTO MISCONDUCT IN THE BANKING, SUPERANNUATION AND FINANCIAL SERVICES INDUSTRY

ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO APPEAR

- 1. Pursuant to s 6FA of the *Royal Commissions Act* 1902 (Cth), each applicant listed in Schedule A has leave:
 - (a) to appear at the hearings commencing on 6 August 2018;
 - (b) to examine any witness that the applicant has nominated to give evidence during the hearings;
 - (c) to cross examine any other witness to the extent that the witness has given evidence during the hearings about the conduct of the applicant;
 - (d) to make written submissions at the conclusion of the hearings:
 - (i) about what findings of fact, if any, may be made about conduct of the applicant examined in the course of the hearings; and
 - (ii) about an issue which the applicant can demonstrate to be an issue in which the applicant has a direct or substantial interest.
- 2. Examination and cross-examination of witnesses is to be conducted and submissions are to be made in accordance with the Practice Guidelines of the Royal Commission.
- 3. The leave now granted may be extended or narrowed from time to time with respect to any or all of the applicants listed in Schedule A.
